Abstract	<p>This small but richly illuminated Book of Hours was made ca. 1300-10 for the Use of Liège. The manuscript was created for a woman, likely a Beguine living in Huy, and inscriptions indicate it continued to be used in that region by another family into the seventeenth century. The number and variety of illuminations in the manuscript are remarkable given its small size, for it contains fourteen extant full-page miniatures, twenty-four calendar images, eleven extant large historiated initials, 188 small historiated initials, and countless marginal drolleries. Although an early rebinding resulted in the loss or rearrangement of several folios, this manuscript remains a fine example of the richness and intimacy of a Book of Hours from this period.</p>

Contents: Use of Liège; one quarter to one half full; graded in red and black ink; twenty-eight virgin saints shows considerable female representation; many saints of Huy indicate intended useage there; notable saints include Mengold (February 8, count of Huy), Lambert (April 28), Domitian (May 7, bishop of Tongres and Huy, patron of Huy), Gengulf (May 11), Servatius (May 13, bishop of Tongres), Monegund (July 1), Helen (August 18, "regine," and the only other with this saint listed this way is British Library Harley 2930, which is also from Liège and made for a woman who was likely a Beguine), Lambert (September 17, bishop of Liège, patron saint of diocese), Remigius (October 1), Hubert (November 3, bishop of Liège, buried at St.-Pierre, Liège), Leonard (November 6), Geneviève (November 26, "Genofeue," also uniquely found this way in a group of Liège manuscripts, see Oliver, 1988), Begga (December 17, "uidue," patron saint of Beguines

Binding

The binding is not original.

Bound in Belgium, ca. fifteenth or sixteenth century; brown leather over wood boards; rebacked, corners repaired, and re sewn on five single cords by Gruel in Paris in late nineteenth or early twentieth century; upper and lower covers have panel stamped design in blind with two columns of four motifs, each in a square, with fleur-de-lis flanking a paschal lamb and an eagle; inscription down center of imagery reads "AVE MARIA GRACIA;" spine rounded and backed; worn gilt edges; evidence of two metal fore-edge clasps on upper and lower boards
